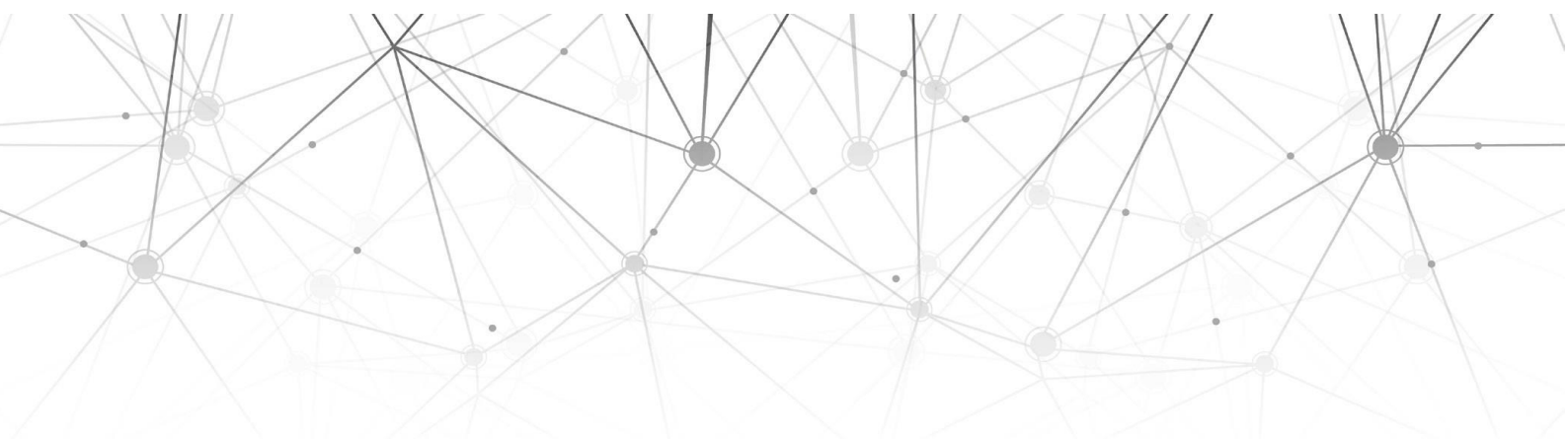

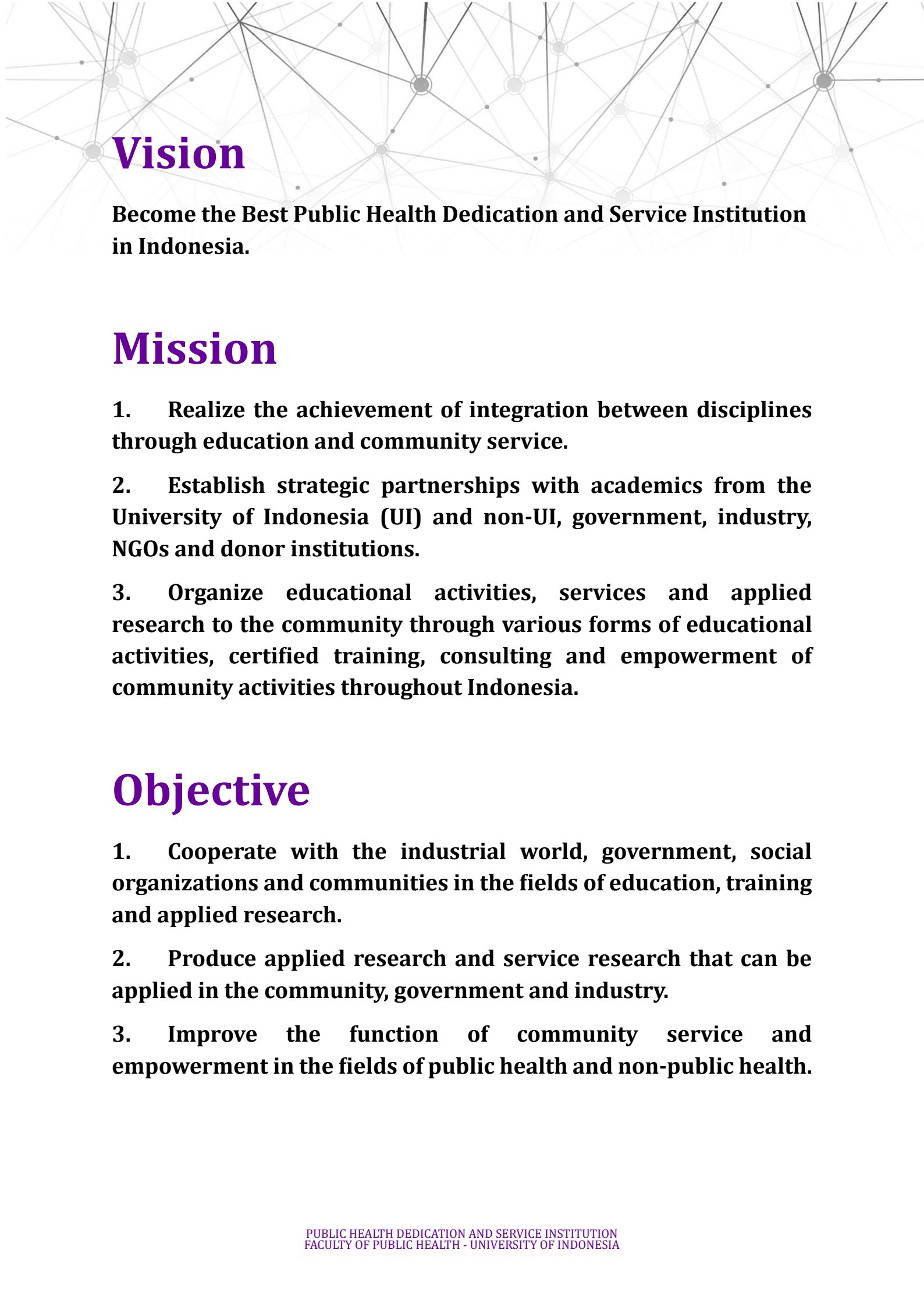


Background

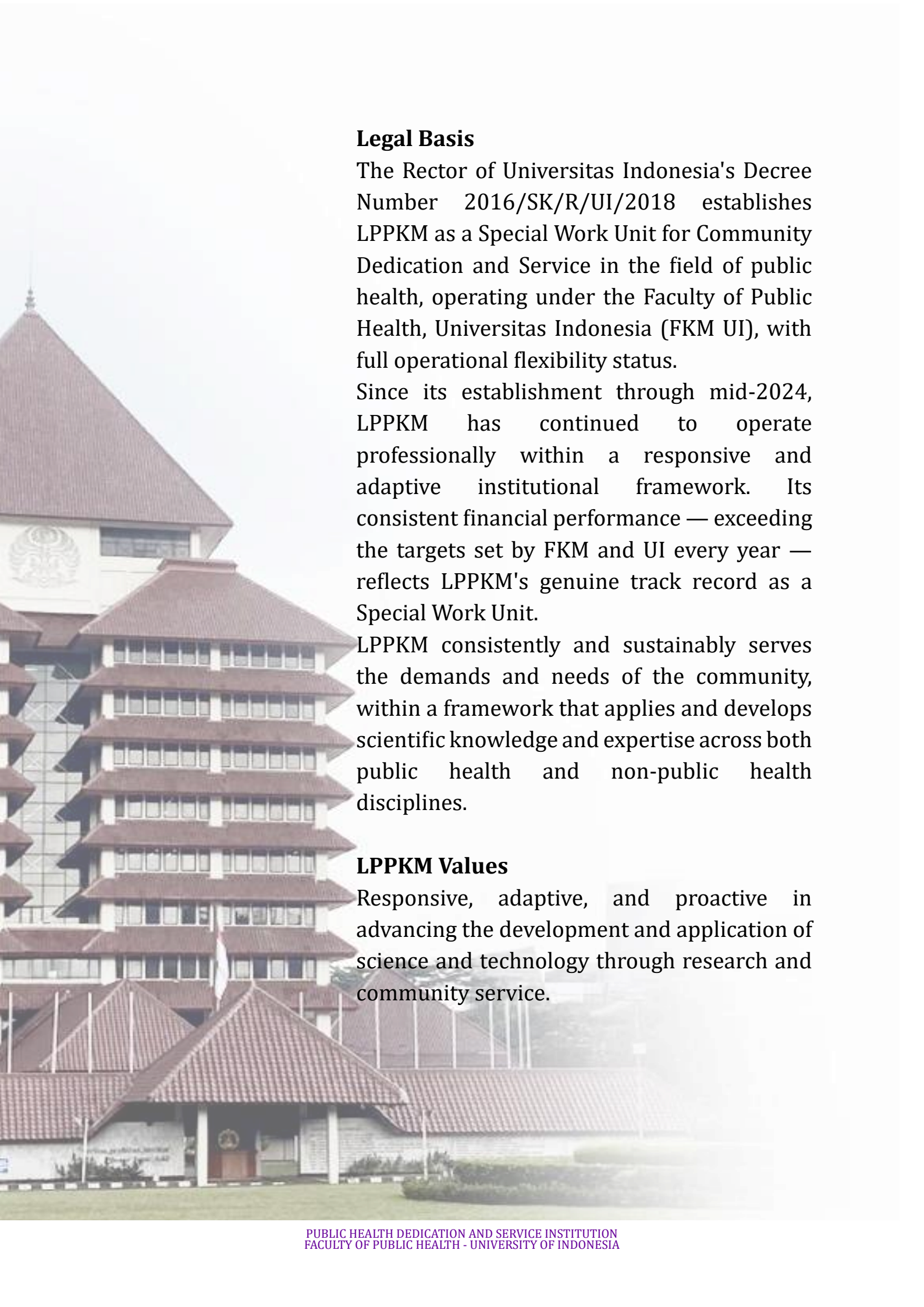
